For Use in Hebrew Studies

Please place the following items in a shopping bag labeled HEBREW

- 4 - three ring looseleafs (soft covered, 1 inch)
- 1 - three ring looseleafs (**hard covered**, 1 inch)
- 5 - 2 pocket folders (without designs or pictures on folders)
- 2 - 2 pocket folders with prongs (without designs or pictures on folders)
- 1 - box reinforcements
- 1 - fabric book cover for סדור

For Use in Both Hebrew and General Studies

- 1 - school box, *labeled with name*
- 3 - 8 oz. bottles of white Elmer's (only) glue *labeled with name*
- 8 - glue sticks *labeled with name*
- 24 - #2 pencils (sharpened) with erasers *in a ziploc bag labeled with name*
- 2 - boxes of primary colored crayons (24 per box) *labeled with name*
- 1 - small box of crayons to keep at home
- 2 - sets of **non-permanent** markers (up to 12 per box) *labeled with name*
